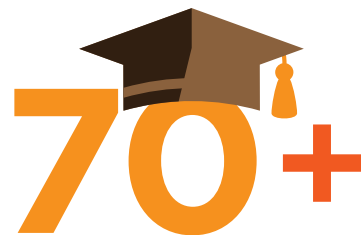

## Indiana Tech Career Center Employer Services:

### 1. Online Job Posting at Indiana Tech

We are pleased to assist you in reaching our talented students and alumni. All full-time, part-time, and internship job postings are housed within Warrior Jobs, our online job posting system powered by Symplicity. You may post positions using this online recruiting service or feel free to contact us and we'll be happy to post those for you. Here's how to use Warrior Jobs:

#### > For New Users

Go to IndianaTech.Edu and at the top, click on "Hire a Warrior." At "What Type of User Are You" click on "Employers." Select the tab labeled "Sign Up" or "Sign Up and Post Job" to request access to recruiting services. Once you submit the registration form online, you should receive login instructions via e-mail within 48 hours.

#### > For Returning Users

If you have used our services before, you may already have an account. Call our office to receive your username. Then, go to the login page (above) and enter your username and password to complete your profile. If you have forgotten your password, select the tab labeled "Forgot My Password" and your username and password will be e-mailed to you immediately.

### 2. Power of Connecting with Tech

Once we have received your posting, the Career Center goes to work for you. Career Center staff regularly promote postings to students and alumni who have indicated they are looking for new opportunities and we share postings with faculty members who share your postings with students. In addition, through Warrior Jobs, students and alumni can create "Search Agents" to regularly send them new opportunities tailored specifically to them so you are reaching the students most relevant to your opening.

One additional benefit of recruiting with Indiana Tech is the reach of your posting. With over 10,000 students located throughout the Midwest, your posting will reach not only the students in your area, but also our traditional age students in Fort Wayne, and all of our CPS students at any one of our 17 campus locations. In addition, as a university with a focus on working adults, you reach more students and alumni with practical experience in their areas of study, many of whom are looking to complete their degrees so they can move to the next level of their profession. But more importantly, our students are learning theory and practice from faculty that are considered industry leaders and innovators, who weave professional experiences and firsthand knowledge into academically rigorous curricula.

### 3. Information Sessions and Career Fairs

Throughout the year, employers have the opportunity to connect with our students who are eager to learn more about various career fields, companies or organizations, internship and volunteer opportunities, and full & part-time employment. Many organizations find it beneficial to give classroom presentations to students or host information tables on campus. These events are a valuable way for employers to network with our students, gain brand recognition and to discuss employment opportunities, whether it is a current opening or a potential future opportunity.

Indiana Tech sponsors a variety of annual career fairs where employers can connect with students, alumni, and Career Center staff. Each year we host targeted fairs focusing on specific industries such as criminal justice, engineering and computer science, business, government, non-profit, and helping professions. In addition, Indiana Tech annually participates in a Virtual Career Fair where employers can interact with a variety of students from an array of fields. ### 4. On-Campus Interviewing

A great way to connect with the talent at Indiana Tech is by holding on-campus interviews. Schedules can be open (any student who meets the criteria is allowed to interview), or employers can pre-select candidates. Either way, the Career Center staff can assist you and provide interview or conference rooms for your use.

### 5. Help Us Train the Candidates You Want to Hire

"We regularly collaborate with employers to assist us in training our students to become polished, confident professionals. We offer – both in person and virtually - mock interviews, phone interviews, Skype interviews, professional dress critiques, LinkedIn reviews, resume reviews, and more. We also have opportunities for employers to participate in our Employer Advisory Board and to provide valuable insight and feedback through surveys throughout the year. We want to make sure we are training our students to be the candidates you want to hire.
